To Maintain and care for the indoor plants, outdoor landscapes, lawns, flowerbeds, trees, shrubs, and other plants. To plant new flowers, shrubs, and trees according to the landscape design. Prune and Trim existing plants to encourage healthy growth and maintain a neat appearance. Prepare soil for planting. Monitor and regulate watering to ensure plants receive adequate moisture without overwatering. Regularly remove weeds from the gardens and other landscaped areas. Perform seasonal tasks such as raking leaves, winterising plants and preparing for spring. Maintain and clean gardening tools and equipment, ensuring they are in good working condition. Encourage sustainable gardening practices by composting organic waste and recycling material where possible. Communicate with the residents, their families, team members and visitor to the home professionally and be courteous at all times.
